What is U3A? The University of the Third Age

University simply means a community learning together. The Third Age follows childhood and working lives and is a time of active retirement.

Tamworth Regional U3A Inc. is part of the world wide U3A movement where retired people from all walks of life get together to teach and learn from each other, drawing on their life's experiences, knowledge and interests.

Joining U3A

No formal qualifications are required to join U3A except that you are over 50, retired or semi-retired. Classes are held in a relaxed, friendly social atmosphere, no exams, no assignments or tests.

Tamworth Regional U3A Inc. operates on 4 terms per year, corresponding to school terms. Courses and Activities are conducted Monday to Friday.

Membership Fee

A single annual Membership fee is charged, however there may be additional costs for some courses and activities to cover venue, equipment hire, photocopying. You may also be required to purchase materials in certain courses.

In 2021 the fee for new members is \$50.00. The fee for members who paid in 2020, but were prevented from attending courses by COVID 19 restrictions, is \$25.00.

What we offer

Tamworth Regional U3A Inc. offers a wide range of subjects which will vary from time to time. These may include languages, literature, art, technology – computers and photography, history, music. Recreational activities include bird watching, craft, croquet, cryptic crosswords, dancing, knitting & crochet, table tennis, tai chi, walking, Mah Jong, bridge, cards.
