Excursion to Calala Cottage Museum 142 Denison Street Tamworth

Now that some normality has resumed after COVID restrictions, Tamworth Regional U3A will recommence on the 1st Wednesday every 2nd month of Term, Excursions to places of interest.

The first Excursion will be to Calala Cottage Museum, Wednesday 2nd June 2021, commencing with morning tea 10am followed by conducted tours of the complex. Cost of the morning is \$10 per person

Calala Cottage Museum is owned by Tamworth Regional Council, however the nationally significant collection is maintained by Tamworth Historical Society Inc with support of local service groups.

Calala Cottage was designed and built by Philip Gidley King in 1875. King became Tamworth's first Mayor in 1876 and used Calala as his townhouse for meetings and welcoming visitors to the district. It is furnished with items from the late Victorian era which are on display in Calala as well as in other buildings in the Museum complex.
